- Eastern Shore superintendents believe that the responsibility to authorize charter schools resides most effectively with the local board of education in each county.
- Charter schools must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations
- Because charter schools are included in each local system's report card, local boards must maintain management authority, including:
 - Assignment and transfer of staff
 - Monitoring operations
 - Evaluating schools
